



## Hyperbaric Health Annual Award for Excellence in HBOT

### **History**

Since 2006 Hyperbaric Health™ has funded an award, Hyperbaric Health Annual Award for Excellence in HBOT "The Wee Rebreather Diver". This prestigious award is given annually by the HTNA to recognise the efforts of an individual member.

The "The Wee Rebreather Diver" is a Perpetual Award that has each recipient listed on the base. Each Recipient also receives a voucher for Best Books, and a plaque, commemorating the Award presentation to keep.

Hyperbaric Health wishes that the process of selection be "simple" and at arm's length from the company. This is to allow all HTNA Members to be eligible for the award; including any employed by Hyperbaric Health.

The Award is to recognise, innovation or exceptional effort to advance clinical, technical, or safe practice in HBOT by an HTNA Member

### **Selection Criteria**

1. The Recipient must be an individual or may be a group of HTNA Members of good standing (current financial).
2. The Award will be presented by a Hyperbaric Health representative at the HTNA Annual Meeting, at the same time as the other Awards are presented.
3. Nomination for the award must be forwarded to the Selection Committee, by 21 days prior to the AGM.

### **Selection Process**

A nomination form is provided in an Edition of "Offgassing" prior to the conference. It is also available on the HTNA website.

The Nomination Committee will consist of three persons. One of each: Dr, RN and Tech. The term of appointment is two years. If any member of this committee is nominated for the award, they should withdraw and one member of the HTNA Executive Committee temporarily replaces that person.

The Selection Committee can freely decide on which nomination is selected by them, no process for selection is prescribed. The only guidance offered is that the nomination fulfils the criteria of: Innovation or exceptional effort to advance clinical, technical, or safe practice in HBOT by an HTNA Member(s).

The Award may only be given in any year when nominations are deemed to be suitable by the Selection Committee.

The number of nominations and the identity of all nominees will remain confidential, and must not be disclosed outside the Selection Committee.
